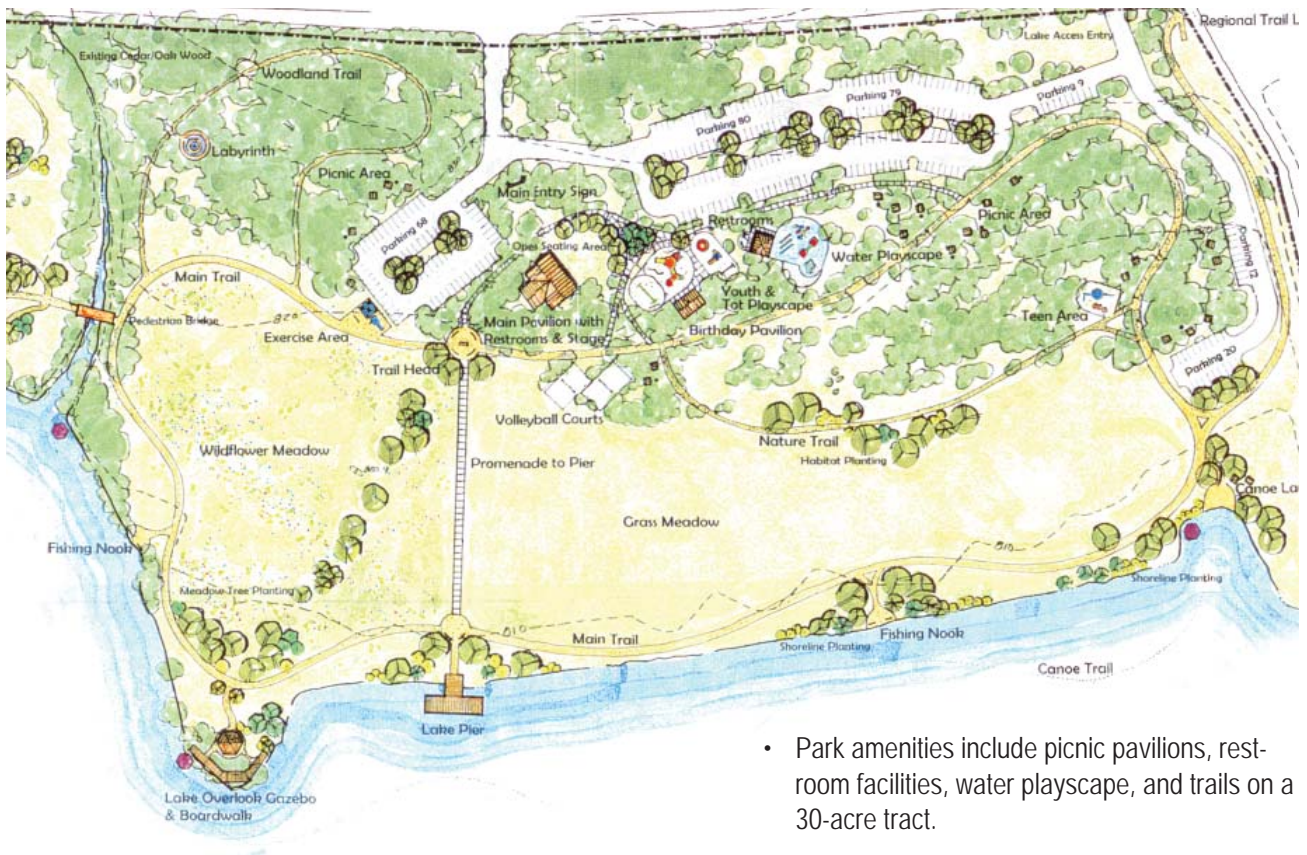




STANSBERRY ENGINEERING CO.

BRUSHY CREEK LAKE PARK located at Parmer Lane and Brushy Creek Road in Cedar Park



- Park amenities include picnic pavilions, restroom facilities, water playscape, and trails on a 30-acre tract.
- Special measures used to protect natural areas during the construction process and maintain the native character of the site.
- Parking lot designed to evenly spread storm-water run-off and minimize areas of concentrated discharge.
- Use of vegetative filter strips in lieu of a typical sand filtration pond satisfied the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality Edward's Aquifer water quality regulations while reducing construction costs and long-term maintenance.
- Trails, parking, and sidewalks meet TAS/ADA regulations.
